The record is quite clear to confirm that Dr. William P. Woods of Evansville, Indiana was the President of the International Association of Lions Clubs and was elected first President of the Association at the Dallas Convention on October 9, 1917 during the three days of programs (see Exhibits "B" & "C"). It is also acknowledged that " Dr. Woods has been at the head of the movement to form an international organization of Lions Clubs." (Exhibit "C")

Since it was determined by the convention that the association's home office shall be located at the city of the president, the letterhead stationery shown above reflects that. The officers shown at the left has Dr. W. P. Woods at President and Melvin Jones is listed as the Secretary-Treasurer.
